BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF FORESTS AND FORESTRY SECTOR IN THE STATE

Chandigarh is a well planned city known all over the world for its architectural planning and landscape. The Master plan of the 'City beautiful' Chandigarh was prepared by Swiss-French architect le Corbusier. It is a Union Territory (UT) of India and serves as capital of the States of Haryana & Punjab. The city was named after the mother goddess of power, Chandi, whose temple Chandi Mandir is located in the vicinity of the site selected for the city. The Chandigarh city is situated in a picturesque setting under the foot of Shivalik Hills at a height of 365 meters above the mean sea level. The city boundaries are defined by two seasonal rivulets – the Patiali ki Rao and Sukhna choe, with the beautiful backdrop of the Shiwalik hills.

The greening is an integral part of Urban Planning in UT Chandigarh. Tree plantation along avenues, open spaces, green belts around building complexes are the enthralling features of the city. A number of beautiful avenues with conspicuous tree species, well wooded forests along the periphery of city, 'Sukhna Lake' against the backdrop of Lake Reserve Forests, green belts running across the length and breadth of the city and a beautiful 'Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuary' on its periphery, further enhance the ecological, environmental and aesthetic richness of the city.

CHANDIGARH IS MORE BEAUTIFUL WITH FORESTS AND FORESTRY SECTOR-

- Two Wildlife Sanctuaries (Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuary & City Bird Sanctuary in Sector-21)
- Nagar Van (City Forest) within the city
- Botanical Garden
- Butterfly Park
- Peacock Park at Sector 39
- Designated wetland called 'Sukhna'- An ideal habitat for Migratory Birds.
- City has replaced all conventional energy street light system with LED.

ACHIEVEMENTS-

- Forests of Chandigarh have been assigned the Rank 1 on Planning Commission's Environmental performance index.
- The forest cover in U.T. Chandigarh is 48.03 sq km and another 25 sq km area is under tree cover.
- The forest in the UT has increased by 0.47 sq km in 2019 as compared to the 2017(Source- ISFR 2019).
- The Green Cover of UT Chandigarh has increased by 71.96 sq km including Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuary from 57.55 sq km to 64.75 sq km at present.

It was informed that the the Department of Forests & Wildlife, UT Chandigarh has completed the afforestation works on different sites as per approved APO (2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21).

Member Secretary (SLSC) further informed that as desired by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, the State Level Steering Committee had approved the Action Plan in the year 2015 to complete the backlog of Compensatory Afforestation works in seven years (2014-2021) as per following details:-

The Department of Forests & Wildlife, UT, Chandigarh has completed the backlog of aforementioned Compensatory Afforestation work as per approved Action Plan of 07 years from 2014-15 to 2020-2021, the department of Forests & Wildlife has prepared the Annual Plan of Operation (APO), 2021-22 for the various component of Compensatory Afforestation, NPV etc.

Following Agenda items as recommended by the State Level Executive Committee were discussed at length during the meeting of State Level Steering Committee for the APO 2021-22 for onward submission to the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi:-

Agenda Item No.1:- Progress Report of Compensatory Afforestation works as well as NPV component for the year 2020-21.

As per the approved Action Plan for the year 2020-21 to complete the backlog, the Department of Forests & Wildlife, UT Chandigarh had demanded Rs.226.26 Lakh from Adhoc-CAMPA, the work has been carried out, but the funds pertaining to UTs could not be released in time. However, season specific works including fresh plantation and maintenance of previous year plantation has been carried out. The payment to be released and an after the receipt of fund.

Agenda Item No. 4 – Approval of Action Plan 2021-22 - School Nursery Yojna launched by Government of India.

As per letter dated 14.10.2020, issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has launched the School Nursery Yojana on pilot basis for a period of 5 years from 2020-21 to 2024-25, which aims at involving young students in growing plants in school nurseries to bring them closer to natural environment, help them understand the natural processes of germination and plant growth and feel the joy of watching saplings grow. The scheme, financially supported by NCAC from the National CAMPA fund aims to engage students of Class VI to Class VIII. Each school will be received Rs. 50,000/- as grant under this scheme. Out of this, Rs. 40,000/- will be used by each proposer school for creation of Nursery with essential facilities. Balance Rs. 10,000/- will be utilized for miscellaneous activities like report preparations, field study, photography, awards etc. in addition, another Rs. 40,000/- will be paid annually to school for keeping a nursery trainer/mali. In case, the same school wishes to raise nursery next year or in subsequent years also, the grant of Rs. 25,000/- will be given to meet the cost of consumable like soil, poly bags or earthen pots, compost/manure etc. as the nursery is already established and will require only planting material.

- The Chairman of SLSC Worthy Adviser to the Administrator advised that in order to sensitize the tourist/public towards nature and nature conservation Jungle safari needs to be organized by the Forests & Wildlife Department and a customized e-Bus is required to be procured under NPV, which can ferry the tourist from some convenient place of the city to the forest area on payment basis. All the members of the committee appreciated the idea. The same has been noted for making suitable change in the proposal under NPV.
- 2) It was also suggested by the worthy Chairman of SLSC that few Air Purifier needs to be installed in the city on a pilot basis, so that the air quality of the city can further improve. If not, under CAMPA possibility needs to be explored under some other scheme.

MONITORING REPORT ON COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION WORKS CARRIED OUT IN CHANDIGARH FOREST DIVISION UNDER CAMPA

As desired by the Department of Forests & wildlife, Chandigarh, the inspection team comprising of Dr Goverdhan Singh Shamet, Dean, College of Forestry and Dr D P Sharma, Professor, Dr Y S Parmar University of Horticulture & Agroforestry inspected the afforestation sites in Maloya and Khudda Lahora village of Chandigarh, planted under CAMPA by the Department of Forests & wildlife, Chandigarh of 19.10.2014.

The team inspected the afforestation sites in the presence of Mr Kuldip, DFO and Mr Karan Singh Range officer. The team recorded and confirmed the GPS location of the afforestation sites. The afforestation works were comprised of Plantation and Fencing work.




