Subject: Punjab Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management & Planning Authority Annual Plan of Operations 2019-20.

Annual Plan of Operation for 2019-20 was approved by the Steering Committee of Punjab Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management & Planning Authority in its meeting held on 23.03.2020 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Punjab. The APO was prepared keeping in view the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 and the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018. Only the permissible activities were included in the APO as per CAF Rules. The APO for 2019-20 is forwarded herewith along with the minutes of the Steering Committee meeting (**Annexure-A**). The outlay on various forestry and bio-diversity activities in APO 2019-20 is for Rs. 10215.81 lakh. Copy of the APO 2019-20 has also already been submitted to your office through e-mail dated 30.03.2020.

An amount of Rs. 1040.84 Crore was transferred in 2019-20 by the Govt. of India, MoEF &CC to the State. The said amount was deposited in the public account of the State Authority.

2. Compensatory Afforestation for 9209 ha. has been done from 2010-11 to 2018-19 and further 1331 ha. plantation under CA has also been done during 2019-20 as per details below:-

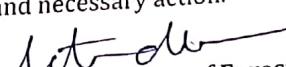

The Steering Committee was informed that Action Taken Report as per directives of the Governing Body, had been sent to ACS, Forests vide U.O.No.116 dated 09.08.2019. The Steering Committee took note of the action taken on the various action points as circulated in the agenda for the meeting.

Agenda Item No.4:- To consider the Proposed Annual Plan of Operation for the year 2019-20 and approve the same.

The CEO, State Authority informed the Steering Committee that the Expert Committee has analyzed all plantations models including the rationale, justification, the unit costs and the species used. The Committee also critically examined the various tending operations and spacing for plantation as well as frequency of weeding and spot irrigation. The Committee in its report concluded that spacing of 3m x 3m followed in plantation helps to provide clear bole and adds to quality of timber. The Expert Committee found other tending operations proposed in the model acceptable and recommended no change in the frequency or quantity of tending works proposed in the APO of 2019-20 as these were considered as minimum requirement.

PCCF (HoFF) intimated that the proposed APO of 2019-20 is in line with the above recommendations of the Expert Committee and there are no deviations from the recommendations of the Committee in APO 2019-20.

After considering the report of the Expert Committee, the Steering Committee approved the APO 2019-20 of the State Authority placed at Annexure-H for Rs 102.15 Crores.

Part-I

**Brief history and Past
performance**

a. Brief description of forest and forestry sector in the State.

Punjab is an agriculture dominated state. About 83 percent of the total geographical area is under agriculture and only 17 percent of the area is under other land uses including forests. In the state, forest areas are owned by Government as well as private individuals and its proportion is about equal. Government forests primarily are in the form of strip forests along roads, canals and railway lines. A few block forests (PFs) also exist in plain areas of Punjab which are known as birs. Apart from this, Shivalik belt supports natural forests of Khair and sisoo. Although privately owned its management however vests with the forest department and it is managed as per the approved management plans by GOI.

As per the revised classification of Forest types of India by Champion and Seth (1968), forest types of plain area is Sub-group 5-B-Northern Tropical Dry Mixed Deciduous Forests with Sub-type E8 Saline and Alkaline Scrub Savannah owing to edaphic factors. The dominant species in plain area include, Shisham (*Dalbergiasisso*), Kikar (*Acacianilotica*), Neem (*Azadirachtaindica*), Safeda (*Eucalyptustereticornis*), Arjan (*Terminaliaarjuna*), Mesquite (*Prosopisjuliflora*), Drek (*Meliaazaderach*), Siris (*Albizzialebbeck*), Dhak (*Buteamonosperma*), Beri (*Zizyphusmauritiana*), Jand (*Prosopiscineraria*), Rajain (*Holoptelaintegrifolia*), Phalahi (*Acaciemodesta*), Toon (*Toonaciliata*), Jamun (*Syzygiumcumini*), Kaner (*Neriumindicum*), Basuti (*Adhatodavasica*), Ak (*Calotropisprocera*), Bhang (*Cannabissativa*) etc.

In Shivalik area, forest types is 5B/C2 (Northern dry mixed deciduous forests) which deteriorates at certain places into the category 5B/DS2(dry deciduous Scrub) Khair, Sisoo Forests in foot hills, Bela and Mand areas (type 5/IS2) and Chil Forest on the higher reaches of Shivalik conforming to the forest type 9C/IA (lower Shivalik Chil Pine Forests). The dominant species in hills area include, Khair (*Acacia catechu*), Shisham (*Dalbergiasissoo*), Kikar (*Acacianilotica*), Mango (*Mangiferaindica*), Chil (*Pinusroxburghii*), Simal (*Bombaxceiba*), Amla (*Emblicaofficinalis*), Rajain (*Holoptelaintegrifolia*), Kembal (*Lanneacoromandelica*), Tun (*Toonaciliata*), Phalahi (*Acaciemodesta*), Neem (*Azadirachtaindica*), Kinu (*Diospyrostomentosa*), Amaltas (*Cassiafistula*), Kangu, (*Flacourtiaramontchii*), Dhak (*Buteamonosperma*), Sannan (*Ougeiniaoojensis*), Wan (*Salvadoraoleoides*), Beri (*Zizyphusmauritiana*),

Dhaman (*Grewiaoppositifolia*), Kachnar (*Bauhiniavariegata*), Chhall (*Anogeissuslatifolia*),
Ziziphusnumularia, Kuri (*Nyctanthesarboretistis*), Dhavi (*Woodfordiafruticosa*), Panchphulli
(*Lantanacamara*), Garna (*Carrissaopaca*), Mehndar (*Dodoneaviscosa*) etc.,

Majority of the forest falls in the category of Protected Forest and some forests are also declared as Reserve Forests. There are 12 Wildlife Sanctuaries, 2 Zoological Parks/Tiger Safari, 3 Deer Parks and 2 Community Reserves in the state. Detail of forest area under various categories is given in the following table.

(f) Brief description and abstract of the monitoring work done by the Monitoring and Evaluation wing of the State Forest Department .

Every year monitoring of the works, new plantations and maintained old plantations under all the schemes is done by Monitoring and Evaluation wing of the department. Field sample checking of work in every Forest Division is done and evaluated against various set parameters like survival percentage, health and vigour of the plants, effectiveness of disease and pest control measures, protection from biotic pressures like forest fire, browsing etc. Average survival rate ranged between 69.25% & 90.20%. Details are given in Table 8below:-
