At the outset, DG FSI, welcomed all the members and special invitees. Thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

Agenda item No. 1 Action taken on the second meeting of MG

Shri Prakash Lakhchaura, DDG made a presentation on action taken on decisions of second meeting of MG. He informed that a presentation on e-Green Watch has been arranged from NIC during the third meeting as desired by MG. A letter has been sent to all SFDs along with the excel format for getting the desired information related to CAMPA. Regarding setting up of a PMU to assist MG, it was informed that National Authority will look after this matter.

Agenda item No. 2 Presentation on limitations of existing e-Green watch portal

Shri Sunil Jain, Sr. Technical Director, NIC, Bhopal gave a presentation on e-Green Watch portal. He highlighted the strength and weaknesses of the existing e-Green Watch. He informed the members about the data availability of different States related to CAMPA. It was decided to select 5-6 States having maximum allocations under CAMPA. These selected States will be communicated to Shri Sunil Jain for getting the available data from the e-Green Watch portal. The data provided by Shri Sunil Jain will be utilised by the MG for monitoring of CAMPA activities. The six States having maximum allocation under CAMPA are Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha and Telangana.

Agenda item No. 3- Discussion on setting up of a PMU for assisting MG for physical and financial evaluation of the works.

Shri Sanjay Kumar Ojha informed that a proposal to constitute a PMU in the National Authority was under consideration. The proposed PMU would consist of 5 Consultants including a Monitoring Consultant. However, the Competent Authority has approved the engagement of 5 individuals as consultants. He also suggested that if a separate PMU for assisting the Monitoring Group is required, the same should be housed in the National Authority

Agenda item No. 4 – Activities to be carried out by MG in next three months

On the basis of the information received from Shri Sunil Jain for the States of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha and Telangana, the MG will take up work of monitoring for 1 or 2 State for which adequate data is available.
