



ABSTRACT

Forests - Indian Forest Service - Re-designation of the existing Cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and Forest Settlement) as Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority in consonance with Section 10 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority Act 2016 and Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018 - Orders issued.

#### ORDER:

In the Gazette Notification first read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, New Delhi have notified the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority Act, 2016.

- 2. In the Gazette Notification second read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change have notified that 30.09.2018 is the date of constitution of State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority. As per the said notification, this State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority will be called as "Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management
- 3. As per sub-section (7) of section 10 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016, (Central Act 38 of 2016), the State Government shall appoint an Officer of the rank not below the rank of a Chief Conservator of Forests as the Chief Executive Officer of the State Authority who shall be the Member-Secretary of the Steering Committee and the Executive Committee of

the State Authority. Further, as per rule 9 of the Compensatory Afforestation. Fund Rules, 2018, the Chief Executive Officer of the State Authority referred to in sub-section (7) of section 10 of the above said Act shall be appointed on deputation basis for a period not exceeding five years by the State Government.

- 4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Department) in the reference third read above, has requested that the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and Forest Settlement) who is holding the above said post at present, may be appointed as Chief Executive Officer of the State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and the said post may be re-designated as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and Forest Settlement) and Chief Executive Officer of the State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority.
- 5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Department) and order as follows:-
  - (i) Existing Cadre post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and Forest Settlement) be redesignated as Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority.
  - (ii) The present incumbent of the post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority and Forest Settlement) will act as Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority on deputation basis in consonance with section 10 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act 2016 and Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018 (or) until further orders.
  - This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.4319/FS/2019, Dated.02.12.2019.

#### ORDER:

The forest lands are being diverted for non-forestry purposes after getting prior approval of Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Compensatory Afforestation is one of the important conditions stipulated by the Central Government while approving proposals for diversion of forest lands. In the Gazette notification second read above, the Government of India have notified the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016, which is an Act to provide for the establishment of funds under the public accounts of India and the public accounts of each State and crediting thereto the monies received from the user agencies towards compensatory afforestation, additional compensatory afforestation, penal compensatory afforestation, net present value and all other amounts recovered from such agencies under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980; constitution of an authority

at national level and at each of the State and Union territory Administration for administration of the funds and to utilize the monies so collected for undertaking artificial regeneration (plantations), assisted natural regeneration, protection of forests, forest related infrastructure development, Green India Programme, wildlife protection and other related activities and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

- 2. Subsequently, in the Gazette notification third read above, the Government of India have published the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018.
- 3. In the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary Notification sixth read above, the Government have established a special fund called the "State Compensatory Afforestation Fund-Tamil Nadu" under interest bearing section of Public Account of the State of Tamil Nadu.
- 4. The disbursement and utilization of the State Fund shall be as per Section 6 of Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016. The accounting procedure to regulate the manner of crediting the monies to the State Fund in a year shall be as per Section 7 of Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016.
- 5. In the Gazette of India Notification fourth read above, the Government of India have constituted State Authority namely "The Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority" with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.
- 6. As per the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 notified by the Government of India vide Gazette of India Notification second read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letters 5<sup>th</sup> read above has sent a proposal for constitution of Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority with the Governing Body, Steering Committee and Executive Committee and requested to issue necessary orders.
- 7. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests as per the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 and Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018 and hereby constitute the Tamil Nadu Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority with the Governing Body, Steering Committee and Executive Committee consisting of the following, with the powers and functions indicated below:-
