**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas, the Central Government has notified the “National Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority” in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of section 8 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 (38 of 2016) (CAF Act, 2016) on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2018, vide gazette notification S.O. 4855(E) dated the 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.

2. Further, the Competent Authority has approved non-official expert members of Executive Committee of National Authority, CAMPA, for a period of two years as per the provisions under Section-9(2) of Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 issued vide notification dated 06.09.2022. Accordingly, the Executive Committee of the National Authority is notified as hereunder:

**3. The functions of the Executive Committee of the National Authority are defined in section 15(1) of the Act and are as under:**

- i. Approval of annual plan of operations of State/UT Authorities;
- ii. Formulate proposals and execute schemes/ pilot projects as per CAF Act,2016;
- iii. To present its decisions to the Governing Body of the National Authority for information.
- iv. Formulate proposals for schemes specified in sub-clause (iii) of clause (b) of section 5;
- v. Execute schemes specified in sub-clause (iii) of clause (b) of section 5;
- vi. Deploy staff on contract or on deputation basis to the posts in the National Authority;
- vii. Formulate proposals for creation of posts in the National Authority at the level of Assistant Inspector General of Forests and other officers;
- viii. Invest surplus amounts available in the National Fund;
- ix. Execute other day-to-day work in respect of receipt of amounts in the National Fund;
- x. Maintain books of account and such other records; facilitate scientific,
- xi. Technological and other assistance that may be required by State Authorities;
- xii. Present its decisions to the governing body of the National Authority for information;
- xiii. Maintain and update a public information system on the National Authority
- xiv. Present all information on its transaction in the public domain; undertake any other work as may be assigned by the Governing Body of the National Authority or the Central Government, from time to time.
