2 . In this regard, the terms and conditions stipulated by the Integrated Finance Division of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change are as under:

- i. Payment of TA/DA to non-official member for attending meeting of the aforesaid committee will be met from the budget of National Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority, MoEF&CC as per rules.
  - ii. TA/DA entitlement in respect of retired Government Officials will be same as per their entitlement at the time of the retirement as per revised rates mentioned in Department of Expenditure (DoE) O.M. dated 13.07.2017. **In respect of other members, TA/DA entitlement will be as applicable to officers in the Pay Level 11 (including Air travel in economy class).**
  - iii. Reimbursement of Air travel will be subject to production of boarding passes for actual use of the facility.
  - iv. Payment of sitting fee of **Rs.6,000/-** per sitting per day for attending the aforesaid meeting by non-official members will be as per instructions issued by DoE on the subject. It is further clarified that Sitting Fee to salaried persons employed in Central Universities/UGC/Central Institutes/Institutions and autonomous bodies wholly or substantially funded by the Central Government should not be paid. However, sitting fee will be paid to the eligible non-Official members and the scientists working in Academic Institutes of Excellence and other R&D organizations under seven scientific Ministries/Departments only.
  - v. TA/DA to non-official members will be regulated as per SR. 190.
  - vi. Entitlement may be restricted to actuals.
  - vii. Relaxation for Air journey, if any, will be as per instruction issued by DoE.
  - viii. Air Tickets may be purchased directly from authorized travel agents viz. M/s Balmer Lawrie & Company Limited, M/s Ashok Travels & Tours and IRCTC. Tickets booking may also be done digitally through the Self Booking Tool/Online booking website/portal of these three authorized agencies only, and
  - ix. Payment be made through e-transfer only.
