Annual Plan of Operation (APO) - Manipur (2019-20): Approval regarding.

Sir/Madam.

The undersigned is directed to refer to letter No.7/19/2010/Forests/CAMPA/41 dated 27.08.2019 of Government of Manipur on the above mentioned subject and convey the approval of the Executive Committee of the National Authority under Section 15 (1) (i) of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF) Act, 2016 for the Annual Plan of Operation - Manipur (2019-20) at a total cost of Rs.30.36 Cr. (Rupees thirty crores and thirty six lakhs only) for carrying out approved activities during the current financial year from the "State Compensatory Afforestation Fund - Manipur" created under Section 4 of CAF Act, 2016.

The APO was discussed in the 4th Meeting of the Executive Committee of the National Authority held on 15.10.2019. The component wise approval accorded by the Executive Committee is as under:

- 3. The approval is subject to the following observations:-
- (i) The approved activities shall be carried out according to Rule 4 of CAF Rules, 2018, i.e. as per the provisions of the State financial rules or any such rules applicable from time to time in the State.
- (ii) There should not be any reduction in allocation for forestry sector in the regular State Budget due to flow of CAMPA funds.
- (iii) The State shall furnish a brief description and abstract of the monitoring work done by the Monitoring and Evaluation Wing of the SFD and by the independent monitor in the State as desired in Part I (f) & (g) respectively of Form XII, to the National Authority for records.
- (iv) The details regarding stipulated and achieved compensatory afforestation since 1980 till last financial year shall be prepared in order to ascertain backlog of compensatory afforestation targets and shall also be furnished to the National Authority for records.
- (v) The findings of monitoring works of State Forest Department and 3rd party shall be furnished to the National Authority for records.
- (vi) Activities proposed in Zoo with an outlay of Rs 46.50 lakhs are not permissible as per Rule 5(4) (j).
- (vii) Preparation of working plan is the core activity of the Forest Department. The proposed outlay of Rs 15.00 lakhs on this account is not permissible.
- (viii) Comprehensive proposal under interest component shall be resubmitted to the National Authority through the Steering Committee for its approval.
- (ix) The State Authority shall ensure that activities proposed from NPV shall be taken up as per the approved working plan/wildlife management plan prescriptions and after due consultation with the Gram Sabha & VFMC, as the case may be and shall be in consonance with the provisions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 under proviso below Rule 5(3) (k).
- (x) Geo-tags of all site specific as well as non-site-specific activities will be provided to the National Authority for records. Polygons of each plantation carried out shall be uploaded on e-Green watch portal.
- (xi) Forest fire prevention and control activity is to be in consonance with National Action Plan on Forest Fire, approved by Government of India in consultation with State Government. The State Authority should come up with State Forest Fire Action Plan for next five years and propose activities from NPV component accordingly.
- (xii) Provisioning of civil works in wildlife areas shall be consistent with approved management plan.
- (xiii) The proposed activities shall be carried out as per approved schedule of rates, approved minimum wages etc.
- (xiv) 'Measurable Outputs' of all physical activities and targets of each permissible activity along with period required for achieving the measurable output may be provided to the National Authority for records.
- (xv) A certificate regarding non-overlapping of activities with other schemes shall also be provided to the National Authority for records.
- (xvi) Activities regarding purchase of vehicles, infrastructure development, wages etc. should be taken up as per decisions taken in the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Executive Committee of the National Authority meeting and if there is any revision in the APO on account of these activities, the same shall be communicated to the National Authority for records.
- (xvii) Repair of vehicles shall be limited to vehicles purchased from the CAMPA funds.
- (xviii) Maintenance of existing infrastructure like residential and official buildings related to frontline staff shall be done from the regular State budget.

- (xix) Maintenance of equipments including computers, printers and UPSs shall be limited to the equipments purchased by the State Authority from CAMPA funds.
- The proposed activities from monies received towards NPV deposited in the State Fund shall be bifurcated in the manner provided in Rule 5(2) and Rule 5(3). Similarly, the proposed activities from the interest accrued on monies in the State Fund shall be bifurcated in the manner provided in Rule 6(a) and 6(b). While doing so the specific sub rule shall also be mentioned against each proposed activity.
- (xxi) The activity wise revised outlay for the APO should be communicated to the National Authority for records, if there is any change in the approved outlay.
