
Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to letter No. Desk-CAMPA/C.R.11(20-21)/49 dated 21st May, 2021 of Chief Executive Officer and Member Secretary, Maharashtra CAMPA regarding submission of APO for financial year 2021-22 and convey the approval of National Authority for taking up the activities regarding voluntary relocation of villages from protected Areas (Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve) as per CAF Rules 5(2)(h) amounting to Rs.100.00 crore. The proposal was discussed in the 14th meeting of Executive Committee of National Authority held on dated 30.07.2021 and was deferred for want of concurrence /vetting from National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA). In view of this NTCA granted its concurrence vide letter F. No. 1-2/2020-NTCA dated 14.02.2022 stating that it does not have funds to support voluntary relocation and funds from CAMPA can be used for voluntary relocation.

2. Further, the matter was placed before 16th Executive Committee of National Authority on 15th March, 2022. The Executive Committee approved the proposal and directed to implement the activity as per rules and regulations.

3. This is issued with the prior approval of Competent Authority.


