**Sub: Approval of deferred activities in the Annual Plan of Operation for the financial year 2024-25 of Jharkhand State CAMPA- reg.**

Sir,

The Annual Plan of Operation for the financial year 2024-25 of Jharkhand was considered in 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> meeting of Executive Committee, in which the activities/works were approved for an amount of **Rs 598.12 crore** (Rupees five hundred and ninety-eight crore and twelve lakh only) by the National Authority. Some of the remaining deferred items were considered by Executive Committee in its 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting, which was held on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2024, where an additional amount of **Rs. 56.50 Crore** (Rupees fifty six crore and fifty lakh only) has been approved for the deferred activities.

2. In view of approval accorded during 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Executive Committee the cumulative total approval accorded by National Authority during financial year 2024-25 is **Rs. 654.62 crore** (Rupees six hundred and fifty four crore and sixty two lakh only) against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 917.18 crore** (Rupees nine hundred seventeen crore and eighteen lakh only). The Executive Committee directed all the States/Union Territories to create pending compensatory afforestation and other mandatory activities till 2024 at the earliest and all efforts should be made in this direction to complete these mandatory activities in a time bound manner in compliance of the conditions mentioned in the approval granted by the Central Government.
