The Executive Committee in its 32nd meeting, held on 14th October 2024, accorded in-principle approval for utilization of surplus fund of an amount of **Rs. 219.05 crore** (Rupees two hundred nineteen crore and five lakh only) under the Compensatory Afforestation as indicated under section 6(a) for future plantation activities as a part of the additional action plans for the period from 2025-26 to 2030-31.

- 2. The State is requested to incorporate plantation activities within the Annual Plan of Operations (APOs) for the next financial year and subsequent years ensuring proper utilisation of the projected surplus amount after keeping adequate provision for meeting of the enhanced cost of Compensatory Afforestation in future and any other mandatory activities.
- 3. The approved activities include plantation on degraded forest land, enrichment planting, creation of nursery stock and other silviculture operations, forest protection measures and soil conservation works for holistic ecological restoration of the project/ treatment area. Proper records of necessary site details, KML file of areas under creation/maintenance with other site-specific measure should be maintained and shared on the website and eGreenwatch portal.
