Sir,

The Annual Plan of Operation for the financial year 2024-25 of Karnataka was deliberated in 28th, 29th and 30th meeting of Executive Committee, in which the activities/works were approved for an amount of **Rs. 275.85 crore** (Rupees two hundred seventy five crore and eighty five lakh only) against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 415.45 crore** (Rupees four hundred fifteen crore and forty five lakh only) by the National Authority. In addition, Executive Committee in its 32nd meeting, which was held on 14th October 2024, accorded approval for an amount of **Rs. 0.65 crore** (Rupees sixty five lakh only) in respect of spill-over activities for the financial year 2023-24.

2. In view of approval accorded during 32nd meeting of Executive Committee the cumulative total approval accorded by National Authority during financial year 2024-25 is **Rs. 276.50 crore** (Rupees two hundred seventy six crore and fifty lakh only), including spill-over activities. The Executive Committee directed all the States/Union Territories to create pending compensatory afforestation and other mandatory activities till 2022 at the earliest and all efforts should be made in this direction to complete these mandatory activities in a time bound manner in compliance of the conditions mentioned in the approval granted by the Central Government.

3. The details of component wise spill-over activities for the APO 2023-24 considered in the 32nd EC are given below:


