The Annual Plan of Operation of Himachal Pradesh State CAMPA for the financial year 2025-26 was considered in 34<sup>th</sup> meeting of Executive Committee of the National Authority held on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2025, in which the activities/works were approved for an amount of **Rs. 143.35 crore** (Rupees one hundred forty-three crore and thirty-five lakh only) by the Executive Committee. Some of the remaining deferred items were considered by the Executive Committee of the National Authority in its 35<sup>th</sup> meeting, which was held on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2025, where an additional amount of **Rs. 111.09 crore** (Rupees one hundred eleven crore and nine lakh only) has been approved for the deferred activities and **Rs. 4.52 crore** (Rupees four crore and fifty-two lakh only) has been approved for the pending liability for the financial year 2024-25.

2. After due deliberations during 34<sup>th</sup> and 35<sup>th</sup> meeting, the total approval given by the Executive Committee of National Authority is conveyed under section 15 (1) (i) of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 for the State Annual Plan of Operation 2025-26 of Himachal Pradesh State CAMPA for an amount of **Rs. 254.44 crore** (Rupees two hundred fifty-four crore and forty-four lakh only) against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 267.65 crore** (Rupees two hundred sixty-seven crore and sixty-five lakh only) and pending liability for an amount of **Rs. 4.52 crore** (Rupees four crore and fifty-two lakh only) for the financial year 2024-25 for carrying out approved activities.
