Sir,

The Annual Plan of Operation of Delhi UT CAMPA for the financial year 2025-26 was considered in 35<sup>th</sup> meeting of Executive Committee of the National Authority held on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2025, in which the activities/works were approved for an amount of **Rs. 44.28 crore** (Rupees forty-four crore twenty-eight lakh only) by the Executive Committee. Some of the remaining deferred items were considered by the Executive Committee of the National Authority in its 36<sup>th</sup> meeting, which was held on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2025, where an additional amount of **Rs. 3.52 crore** (Rupees three crore and fifty-two lakh only) has been approved for the deferred activities for the financial year 2025-26.

2. After due deliberations during 35<sup>th</sup> and 36<sup>th</sup> meeting, the total approval given by the Executive Committee of National Authority is conveyed under section 15 (1) (i) of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016, for the Annual Plan of Operation 2025-26 of Delhi UT CAMPA for an amount of **Rs. 47.80 crore** (Rupees forty seven crore and eighty lakh only) against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 51.12 crore** (Rupees fifty-one crore twelve lakh only) for carrying out approved activities.
