The Annual Plan of Operation of Chhattisgarh State CAMPA for the financial year 2025-26 was considered in 34th meeting of Executive Committee of the National Authority held on 23rd April 2025, and 35th meeting, which was held on 4th July, 2025, in which the activities/works were approved for an amount of **Rs. 531.78 crore** (Rupees Five hundred thirty-one crore and seventy-eight lakhs only) by the Executive Committee. Some of the remaining deferred items were considered by the Executive Committee of the National Authority in its 36th meeting, which was held on 9th October, 2025, where an additional amount of **Rs. 5.35 crore** (Rupees Five crore and thirty-five lakhs only) has been approved for the deferred activities.

2. After due deliberations during 34th, 35th and 36th meeting, the total approval given by the Executive Committee of National Authority is conveyed under section 15 (1) (i) of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 for the State Annual Plan of Operation 2025-26 of Chhattisgarh State CAMPA for an amount of **Rs. 537.13 crore** (Rupees Five hundred thirty-seven crore and thirteen lakhs only) against the proposed outlay of **Rs. 694.184 crore** (Rupees Six hundred ninety-four crore and eighteen lakhs only) for carrying out approved activities.
