As per the guidelines of CMPA issue by Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, dated 2/7/2009 "Third Party Monitoring of CAMPA works is conducted by independent monitoring agency, decided based on e-tendering. The Monitoring agency is taking up monitoring of 5% of plantations, based on the random sample selection.
