Sir,

Apropos the above-mentioned communications received from the National Authority, CAMPA, it is intimated that the implementation of CAMPA activities in the Union Territory of Ladakh commenced recently, with the first Annual Plan of Operation (APO) initiated during FY 2023-24, followed by the second APO in FY 2024-25. Accordingly, only two APOs have been implemented so far.

- 2. Therefore, to initiate the monitoring process, Internal Monitoring and Assessment Committees have been constituted for both districts of the Union Territory of Ladakh to review and assess the works executed under the approved CAMPA APOs of FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25. The order constituting the said committees is enclosed herewith for kind information.
- 3. The committees shall inspect and assess all works implemented through CAMPA funds under the respective APOs and submit their monitoring and assessment reports by 31st March 2026 or earlier.
- 4. Subsequent to the completion of internal monitoring and submission of the reports, third-party monitoring shall be undertaken by engaging an independent agency through the prescribed process, to further validate and assess the quality, effectiveness, and impact of CAMPA interventions in the Union Territory of Ladakh.
- 5. This issues with the approval of APCCF/ CEO, Ladakh CAMPA.
